Guadalupe County to Hold Bulk Clean-up Event

GUADALUPE COUNTY, TX –Guadalupe County, in conjunction with the County's solid waste services, will hold a Bulk Clean-up event on Saturday, June 8, from 7:30 to 11:30 AM. The event will take place at the Road & Bridge Department, which is centrally located within the county at 310 IH 10 West Frontage Road at North Guadalupe Street in Seguin.

All vehicles are required to enter from North Austin Street and turn onto North Guadalupe Street, which is 0.5 mile north of IH-10. Vehicles will be guided to the Road & Bridge Central Yard to the proper disposal area and then directed to exit onto the IH-10 Frontage Road. Please note that there is no entry access from the frontage road, and all vehicles must enter the yard from Austin Street.

Residents must show a photo ID or utility bill to prove they reside within Guadalupe County. Bulk Cleanup event is free and allows residents to declutter and dispose of unwanted items to help maintain a clean and safe environment.

No commercial disposal is allowed. A list of items that will be accepted and NOT accepted can be found on the county website: **co.guadalupe.tx.us**

Accepted Items:

- Trash (paper, plastics)
- Junk debris
- Furniture (sofas, mattresses, etc.)
- Household appliances (stoves, washers, dryers, dishwashers)
- Scrap metal
- Scrap tires less than 19.5" (without rims) Limit 4. No rims attached.
- Dry paint
- Bagged yard waste

Not Accepted:

- Hazardous Materials or chemicals (gasoline, used oil, liquid paints, acids, bases, anti-freeze, etc.)
- Batteries (Lead, NiCd, Lithium)
- Brush/Limbs

- Fencing
- Sheds
- Construction material & debris (asphalt shingles, insulation, sheetrock, etc)
- Dead livestock/pets
- Junk vehicles
- Oil-based paint
- No dump trailers
- No gas in mowers or equipment
